3.	Minutes of the previous meetings					
	The minutes of 21 st September 2021 were accepted as being correct (Proposed Cllr. Celfyn Furlong, seconded Cllr. Gwilym O. Jones.)					
4.	Matters arising from the minutes.					
4.1	Playing Field:- The work on the safety surfaces was outstanding. Cllr. Gwilym Jones had contacted the County Council about the equipment promised by Kenton Jones. He was told that the practice with new houses is that the developer is responsible for the houses for the first year and that the County Council holds back a percentage of the value of the contract until the end of that period. Kenton Jones had therefore argued that as the construction contract continued to run until February 2022, they had until the end of the period to finish all the work. The County Council had expressed their disappointment that they had taken that attitude and had asked them to reconsider. They also said that they would not release the final payment until everything was finished satisfactorily.					
4.2	Footpaths:- It was agreed to cut footpath No 5 -Tyn Rhos /Tyn Main, footpath No 28 - Tros Lon / Llyn Dinam and footpath No16 past the Church in Llanfihangel yn Nhowyn. The clerk had also received reports of excessive growth on footpath No 23 but this needed to be checked out first. Public Rights of Way - Public Rights of Way Map (anglesey.gov.uk)					
4.3	Notice Board – The RAF Padre had confirmed that they were happy to assist with and share a notice board with the Community Council but the council would be responsible for sourcing and erecting the board in the Church Grounds. To proceed the Council was required to complete an 8 page method statement form and carry out a ground site scan to ensure there was nothing buried in the area. It was agreed that this may prove to be too expensive and that the clerk would revisit the option to erect a sign on County Council ground next to the church buildings.					
4.4	Traffic / Parking Issues - a request had been made for double yellow lines on the A5 by the village hall. Cllr. Gwilym O. Jones reported that he had arranged a site visit to					

	discuss the concerns raised by residents in the September Council Meeting and that the County Council had agreed to create new passing spaces on the lane past Cerrig lago towards the inland sea. A request was also made for a street light on the junction on to Cymyran Road but there was no electricity supply there to support this.				
4.5	Any other matters arising from the minutes Sportsman Building – The clerk would report that the vegetation from the grounds was encroaching on to the pavement in front of the property.
