3. Minutes of the meeting held on the 15 June 2021

4. Matters arising from the minutes.

4.1 Playing Field:- The basket swing was due to be installed on 22.7.21, Cllr. Gwilym Jones would meet them on site to let them know where it was to be placed. Cllr. Dyfed Williams had put up new signs but the maintenance work on the play area would be carried out after the children returned to school in September

Kenton Jones had still not put up the wooded play house and benches that had been promised.

The Tywyn Trewan Board of Conservators had been informed following the last meeting that the Community Council was not in favour of putting up a locked gate on the lane to Cymyran and members were still adamant that local residents should continue to have
